INTRODUCTION

About The Y



<u>The Y</u> is the largest global youth movement, reaching almost 65 million people in 120 countries. Our vision is for a better world, with and for young people.

In Australia, we offer a wide range of programs and services that support children and young people across their life cycle, from early learning and kindergarten programs to meaningful career pathways, through to recreation and other supports for older Australians, with over 23 million participations each year in over 650 communities across Australia.

The Y movement in Australia comprises 12 Member Y Associations united by our strong shared history of working to solve community problems and standing with, and for, young people.

The Y Canberra has grown with the region, evolving side-by-side since 1941, growing to serve the entire region and areas of NSW.

About Youth Parliament

Running in every state and territory across Australia, <u>Youth Parliament</u> is the Y's flagship civics program that engages around 400 young people aged 16–25. Participants re-enact parliamentary processes, take on leadership roles and formulate bills to gain a better understanding of civic participation and form connections with one another and their community.

There is a great need for this program. 62% of Year 10 students do not meet or exceed the proficient national standard for the National Assessment Program for the Civics and Citizenship Curriculum (NAP-CC) in 2019.

But is the failure to grasp civics topics the fault of young people if they are being excluded from civic participation?

Civics is more than politics. Derived from the Latin word 'civicus', meaning 'relating to a citizen', topics relating to civics should allow the space for young people to not only understand the processes but be part of enacting real positive change in their communities. That's the purpose of the Youth Parliament program.

About ACT Youth Parliament

The YMCA Youth Parliament for the Canberra Region sees 25 young people aged 16–25 from Canberra and the surrounding region representing their community and young people in our ACT Legislative Assembly. The Youth Parliament is an opportunity for the Y Members of the Legislative Assembly (YMLAs) to learn about the role of our ACT Legislative Assembly and our place in civics and democracy. Youth Parliament is a platform that empowers participants to use their voice as a young person, representing our community.

In 2025/26, the Canberra Youth Parliament will be led by a central theme of



This not only embodies the spirit of the Youth Parliament but also uses a direct, empowering approach to call on young people in the Canberra region to get involved and have a say. Through a collectivist, peer-to-peer approach, the campaign seeks to break down the barrier of young people feeling as though they do not have a voice, or they do not fit a pre-determined mould, to be included in decisions that determine their future – empowering them to work together as they advocate for a better future.
